THE COOKING CORNER

TACO SALAD DIP

- 1 16 oz can of Re fried Beans
- 1 8 oz container of Sour Cream
- 1 pkg of Taco Seasoning Mix
- 1 or 2 Roma Tomatoes
- 1 small can of Black Olives
- Green Onions chopped
- 8 oz of Shredded Cheddar cheese
